

Holland ISD Earn Additional State Academic Awards

Holland ISD district and campuses earned nineteen Gold Performance Acknowledgement Awards from the Texas Education Agency for 2011. The Texas Legislature created the Gold Performance Acknowledgements in 2001 to recognize district and campuses for high performance in areas in addition to those used to determine the state accountability ratings.

The Holland School District received accolades in Attendance, Advanced Courses offered at Holland High School along with accomplishments for College Readiness. The district also received awards for commended performance in social studies, while showing improvement in Math and English Language Arts.

Holland Elementary received Gold Performance Acknowledgement Awards for the percentage of students earning Commended Performance in Math, Reading, and Science. Holland Middle School received Gold Performance Acknowledgement Awards for the percentage of students earning Commended Performance in Writing, Social Studies, and Science. The middle school campus received an additional award for Attendance. Holland High School received Gold Performance Acknowledgement Awards for Attendance, College Readiness, Advanced Courses, Improvement in English Language Arts and Math, and for the number of students earning Commended Performance in Social Studies.

Holland ISD is rated as Recognized according to the Texas Education Agency. These additional recognitions reflect how most of the students in the district are performing at the highest level of achievement on state assessments.
